On behalf of the 2016-2017 Board, I would to invite you to attend the Annual Meeting of Skyline Property Owners Association on May 8, 2017. It will be held at the UVU Sorensen Student Center in Orem . Doors will open at 6:00 pm for sign-in with dinner being served at 6:30 and the business meeting beginning at 7:00. As a reminder, changes to the Dues are set by a vote of the Members while Individual Lot Assessments are established and set by the Board.
